Hungary Visa Checklist — India Passport (Visa Required)

VISA REQUIRED

Tourist - C (Schengen) visa (short-stay)

Short-stay uniform visa (C): maximum 90 days
in any 180-day period (single, double or
multiple entry as issued).

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS / VISA CHECKLIST

- 1 Completed and signed Schengen C visa application form (download from the official consular site).
- 2 Valid passport: issued within last 10 years, at least 2 blank pages, and validity extending at least 3 months beyond the intended date of departure from the Schengen area.
- 3 One passport-size colour photo (not older than 6 months) meeting Schengen photo requirements.
- 4 Proof of intended means of transport and itinerary (flight reservation/ticket).
- 5 Proof of accommodation for the entire stay (prepaid hotel reservation or confirmation; if staying with family/friend, proof of sponsorship/private accommodation).
- 6 Travel medical insurance covering entire trip (including return) and additional 15 days, minimum EUR 30,000 coverage; use insurers listed/approved for Schengen procedure (see embassy's approved list).
- 7 Proof of financial means: original bank account statement showing transactions for the last 3 months (stamped/signed), and income tax return acknowledgement for the last 3 assessment years (if applicable).
- 8 If employed: employer's reference, employment contract and payslips for the last 3 months and employer's approval for leave.
- 9 If self-employed/company owner: company registration documents and tax/payment evidence (e.g. GST for India).
- 10 If sponsored: sponsor's bank statements, proof of relationship, sponsor's ID/passport copy and sponsorship letter.
- 11 If student: certificate of enrollment and proof of leave/permission from educational institution; if applicable, sponsorship documents.
- 12 Minors: notarised written consent of the non-traveling parent(s)/guardian(s) if traveling with only one parent or alone; copy of parents'/guardians' ID; court order if sole custody.
- 13 Copies of passport identity pages and copies of any Schengen visas held in the last 3 years (if applicable).
- 14 Purpose-specific documents for tourism: booking confirmation(s), detailed itinerary and means of travel between Schengen states (if visiting multiple states, accommodation proof for each).
- 15 Biometric data will be collected if applicable; visa fee must be paid on submission (amount not stated on these pages).

Disclaimer: Visa and entry requirements can change. Final admission, visa issuance and immigration decisions remain subject to the relevant government, embassy, consulate or immigration authority. Check the official source again before travel.



VISA CHECKLIST - CONTINUED

- 16 Applications must be lodged within 6 months of the intended visit; submit supporting documents as specified by the consulate/VFS (consul may request additional documents).

Passport validity

Passport issued within last 10 years; contains at least 2 blank pages; valid at least 3 months beyond intended date of departure from Schengen area.

Photo requirements

Passport-size colour photo, not older than 6 months (per consulate instructions).

Financial proof

Original bank statement showing movements for the last 3 months (stamped/signed), Indian ITR acknowledgements for last 3 assessment years; payslips for last 3 months if employed; pension statements if retired; sponsor's financial documents if applicable.

Travel insurance

Travel medical insurance valid for entire trip plus additional 15 days, covering at least EUR 30,000 and valid for all Schengen member states; use insurer from the embassy/consulate approved list.

Travel / stay proof

Proof of transport and itinerary (flight reservations/tickets); round-trip or onward travel proof; accommodation reservations for whole stay (and for each Schengen country if visiting multiple states).

For minors

If travelling with one parent: notarised consent of the other parent/guardian (or court order for sole custody). If travelling alone: notarised consent of both parents/guardians. Provide copies of parents'/guardians' ID.

Processing / application note

Decision normally within 15 calendar days; may be extended up to 45 calendar days in individual cases. In India, short-stay (C) visa applications are submitted via VFS Global per consular jurisdiction (see embassy/consulate pages for VAC locations and appointment procedures). Appeal must be lodged in writing within the time limits stated by the consulate; visa fees are not reimbursed in case of refusal.

Additional notes

Official pages state that nationals of India require a valid Schengen C visa to enter Hungary and that a visa is only a preliminary permission — border authorities may still require proof of conditions of entry and return. The official pages do not state the visa application fee amount; consult the consulate/VFS for current fee and for the embassy's approved list of insurers.
